SOKOL MEMBERSHIP. At least one parent is required to be a Sokol member. The annual fee is \$65 January through December. The membership fee for new incoming members who join for the gymnastics program in the Fall is adjusted to \$40 plus a one-time initiation fee of \$15, making it \$55.

NEW MEMBERS: Two choices in paying your membership fee:

- 1) Pay the \$55.00 prorated fee at class registration time, then pay the \$65.00 annual membership by January 1.
- 2) Pay the entire \$120.00 for the remainder of 2017 and for 2018 at class registration.

(Membership dues for 2018 will be required for your child to remain in gym classes after January 1, 2018. Your 2018 membership will include all swimming pool privileges next summer, and allow you to rent the hall facilities for private social events, such as weddings, showers, reunions, etc.)

EXISTING MEMBERS: Current Sokol KHB members will be receiving their 2018 dues notices within the next two months.

REGISTRATION FEE per participant, for the season, is \$50. This is a one-time fee per student per season and is non-refundable. This fee is due at the time of registration.

TUITION MONTHLY DUE DATE: In order to reserve your child's spot in their class, tuition is due by the 15th of each month. After the 15th, a \$10 late fee will be assessed. If tuition is not paid by the 30th of the month, your child will be considered dropped and will not be allowed on the floor to participate in class until the tuition is paid in full. There is no guarantee that their spot will still be available once they are dropped. Payments made by check or money order should be payable to American Sokol of Ennis. Cash will only be accepted if placed in an envelope with the child's name on it. Tuition may also be paid monthly via PayPal on our website www.sokolennis.com under the Payments/Donations link in the left side column.

UNIFORM: Each Sokol gymnastics class will have a required uniform that the student is responsible for purchasing. The required uniform will be worn for performances and may be worn for class. Gymnasts must wear proper workout attire.

1 hour class 2x week	Girls Levels I \$90.00 per month beginning in October (Sept billed at 1x price) \$690.00 for the season if paid during the first month
1 hour class 2x week	Girls Levels II \$90.00 per month \$720.00 for the season if paid during the first month
1-1/2 hour class 1x a week	Girls Levels 3, 4 & 5 \$70.00 per month \$525.00 for the season if paid during the first month
1-1/2 hour class 2x a week	Girls Competitive Gymnastics Levels 3, 4 & 5 \$100.00 per month beginning in October (Sept billed at 1x price) \$770.00 for the season if paid during the first month

Families having more than one child enrolled in our program will receive a tuition adjustment of \$5 per child after full payment of the first child.

Those paying for the entire year have the option of paying with a credit card or PayPal.

Using PayPal for either monthly or annual tuition includes a 3% fee that is added to the payment option.

CLASS RULES

1. Participants are to stay in designated sitting area until their class is called to the floor.
2. Gymnasts **MUST** wear proper attire.
Girls: Leotards are required. **NO** t-shirts will be allowed.
The official Sokol uniform may be purchased and worn to class.
Boys: Stretch shorts and T-shirts. **NO** baggy shirts or jeans shorts will be allowed.
3. Hair must be secured back from the face. Ornamental clips/bows are not acceptable.
No jewelry (Stud earrings will be allowed).
4. Parents are not allowed on the floor and should sit in designated seating area.
 - Parents should not interact with children in class as such distractions can result in injuries.
 - Children not participating in class should be seated with their parents and should not play on apparatus.

THESE ARE IMPORTANT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS WHICH WILL BE ENFORCED.
5. Food and drinks are allowed only in designated area. Trash should be placed in a waste basket.
6. Children should be picked up promptly after class
7. Children must wait for their ride inside the building.
8. Tuition payments are due on the first of each month.
9. Failure to pay by the 15th of the month will result in a \$10 late fee being assessed. If tuition is not paid by the 30th of the month, your child will be considered dropped and will not be allowed on the floor to participate in class until the tuition is paid in full.
10. No chewing gum allowed.

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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT SOKOL

The name Sokol: Sokol is the Czech word for Falcon, a courageous, agile bird; fast and high flying.

KHB: The initials of Karel Havlicek Borovsky [October 31, 1821 - July 29, 1856], a Czech writer, poet, political journalist, publisher. He advocated ideas like universal suffrage (right to vote) and Czech national independence. Our Ennis unit is named for him.

The Sokol motto: A healthy mind in a strong body.

How Sokol started: Dr. Miroslav Tyrš [August 17, 1832 –August 8,1884] (*whose name is on our swimming pool*) and Jindrich Fügner founded the Sokol organization in 1862 in Bohemia. Tyrš was a Czech art historian and educator. His bad physical condition in earlier life gave him an interest in sports to strengthen himself, and he came to create a system of physical training based on the Greek ideal of harmony between physical and mental values.

What we say at the end of every class: The instructor calls out, “Nazdar!” which is the Czech word for “To Success!” The students then answer, “Zdar!” which means simply, “Success!”

Slet: A Sokol gymnastics meet. Our Southern District (Texas and Oklahoma) has a slet every June. The American Sokol hosts a national slet every 4 years.

The Sokol philosophy: While there are plenty of competitive opportunities, Sokol equally serves those who don't strive for a top sport performance, but simply like to exercise, be fit and healthy, and want to enjoy the experience.
